To Shave or Not to Shave?

Shaving Double-Coated Breeds


This "hot" topic has been debated for years. Here's some thoughts to chew on. First, let's consider different types of coats. There are dogs with hair that will grow and grow unless it is cut. Then there are dogs with fur that grow to a determined length. Doublecoated breeds have a fluffy, insulating undercoat and a weather resistant outer coat. Cutting hair short on breeds without undercoat —long or curly hair—has no risk. But, cutting double-coated breeds can cause irreversible damage to the coat. Hair may grow back patchy and have a different texture. They usually lose their beautiful outer coat that is protective and weather resistant. The undercoat grows and tries to become the outer coat, resulting in "brillo pad" feeling fur. Shaving them down does not keep them cooler. Rather, it exposes their thin skin to the elements. Shaving a double-coated breed also does not stop the shedding. It sheds the same, just with shorter, pointy hairs. Of course, the exception to shaving a double-coated breed is if the fur is matted and the only humane choice is to shave it off. In summary, keeping your double-coated breed brushed and washed regularly is the best thing you can do. We offer a great Shedding Treatment available in our salon or for purchase that stimulates the hair follicles and allows us to remove more undercoat than normally possible. Coat, freshly groomed and free from undercoat.



Cool air can reach the skin and circulate when undercoat and mats are removed. The sun's rays will bounce off the coat.




Coat with moderate undercoat.

Cool air is blocked when the undercoat starts growing in, causing the dog to overheat. The undercoat will absorb the rays due to a more porous structure. trapping the heat in.



Coat with impacted undercoat.



When the coat is shaved the cool air flows above the skin. The sun's rays penetrate whatever thin hair is left, causing the dog to overheat. Since a dog's skin is only 6-10 layers deep (compared to a human's 16-20) they will easily sunburn.

You Can Can with Cans!

Canned food is so trending right now. It's not without merit either. Here's some pros to feeding canned food:

- It is less processed than kibble
- Due to airtight packaging, there are no synthetic preservatives
- There are typically fewer carbohydrates in can vs. dry foods
- More palatable/appetizing for finicky eaters
- Good source of hydration for dogs that have low water intake
- Older dogs with missing teeth can eat canned food more easily
- Moisture content occupies more volume so a dieting dog will feel fuller
- May be used as a "topper" on kibble for finicky dogs

Ouick note: Dry dog food does not "clean" your dog's teeth. This is an old myth. Imagine if we ate pretzels or tortilla chips to clean our teeth? If you really want to help your dog's teeth, give them a raw bone. The enzymes break down plaque and tartar. Check out raw bones in our chest freezer of frozen goodies!

OVER-FEEDING YOUR FISH?

Properly feeding your fish helps them to stay healthy and is helpful in maintaining your aguarium. Unfortunately, fish will come to the top of the tank and seemingly "beg" for food whenever you walk by. Don't be tempted! Overfeeding is a major cause of fish loss. It results in the accumulation of uneaten food & excess fish waste which can toxify the water and

stress the fish which then makes them prone to disease.

Decaying food and waste results in the following:

- High ammonia & nitrates which is toxic to fish.
- Low oxygen levels. When food decays, it uses oxygen & produces carbon dioxide.
- Low pH levels. Acids are produced during the decay process which lowers pH and stresses fish out.
- Fatty livers in the fish which can result in death
- Algae blooms, cloudy water, & clogged filters!

So, what's some feeding tips?

- -Feed on a schedule, typically once a day
- A fish stomach is only about the size of their eyeballs. Don't give them more than their tiny stomachs can handle.
- If food is hitting the bottom of the tank or being sucked up by the filter, you're probably feeding too much.
- Invest in a high quality food. It'll save your tank from being cloudy and keep your fish healthy.
- -Add a scavenger like a catfish for freshwater tanks or crabs for salt water tanks. They will help eat food that may accumulate on the tank floor and they are fun to watch!


